Description/Outline of Event/Activity –

The Swimarathon is based on a team event.

Six members to a team and each member swims individually at any one time in a relay system over a total team period of one hour.

The pool has five lanes which allows a maximum of five teams to swim at the same time.

Significant Hazards —

Normal swimming pool hazards in the water.

Slipping on wet surfaces surrounding the pool.

Lack of control/supervision by Lifeguards and Event Organisers.

Groups of people at risk -

Swimmers, Organisers, Helpers and Audience.
